
Mario Mirabile MAPS EFIAP

He has been actively participated in International Exhibitions since 2011 and received many awards from Exhibitions all over the world. Joe's major areas of interest in photography includes sports, travel, photojournalism and landscape.</p> <p>To date, Joe has been awarded over 13,710 acceptances and has won 1,800 awards from international exhibitions over 70 countries. This includes 53 FIAP Blue Pins for "Best Author", 100 PSA Gold medals, 75 FIAP Gold medals and over 1,600 other awards.</p> <p>Joe has been listed in the world top ten of PSA's Who's Who in Photography for 4 years, including the second place in 2012, first place in 2013 and 2014, as well as seventh place in 2016. Collectively, Joe has obtained a total of 12 top ten awards in 4 different categories in 4 years.</p>	

Academically, Joe has completed his MBA with Deakin University in 2000. On his photographic accreditations, Joe has attained his distinction of APSEM/b in 2020 from the Australian Photographic Society (Australia) and EFIAP/diamond 3 from FIAP (Europe) in 2020. He was the first Australian Chinese to receive the GMPSA from PSA (USA) in 2016. Joe has obtained his Bronze Portfolio (BPSA) in 2016 and subsequently the Silver Portfolio (SPSA) Honor in 2019.

Additionally, Joe has been awarded other international photographic accreditations of Crown 5 and VIP-5 from Global Photographers Union (GPU); BP.ICS, GM.ICS from ICS and FWIEP Fellowship from Wilmington International.

Joe joined APS in December 2010 and has been appointed as verifying officer by APS since June 2016 to verify APS and FIAP distinction applications. He served as a Star Ratings Coordinator of the PSA Photo Travel Division for over 2 years and is currently appointed as Vice President of the International Union of Photographers (IUP) of China and Executive Director of the Australian Horizon Photographic Club in Sydney.
