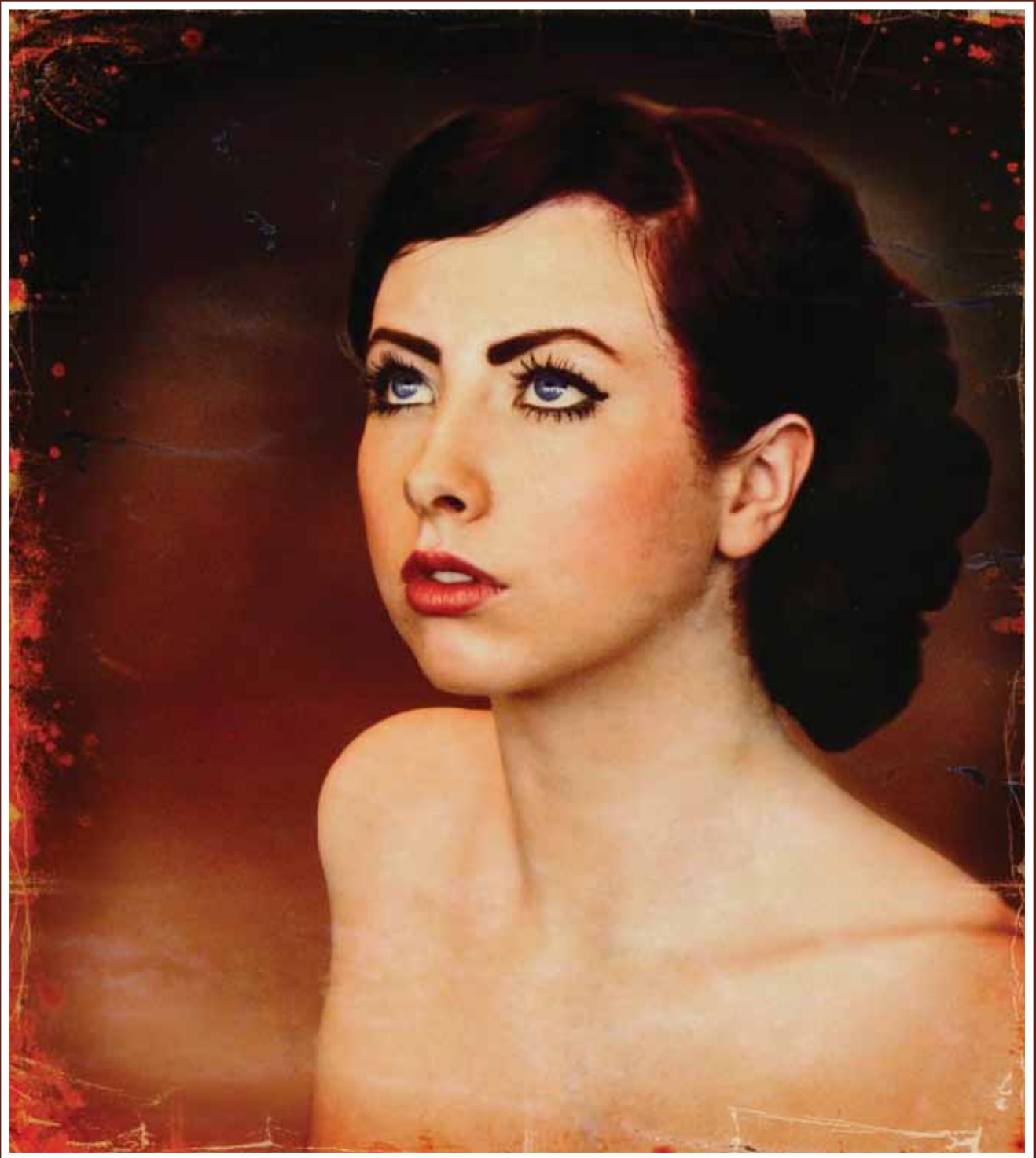

Tribute

Joan Eileen Tucker AFIAP FAPS

This year's VIGEX Salon is dedicated to Joan Tucker.

Joan was a very special and unique person in this salon's history. She joined the Geelong Camera Club in 1998 and not only excelled with her innate photographic talent, but contributed back to her club serving on their committee for 5 years and teaching in the Digital Photography Courses offered to the general public. In Feb 2001, she also joined the committee running the VIGEX International Photographic Salon and within months was assisting in the secretarial role, a role she took on fully from September that year and continued for over 7 years.

Joan first took an interest in photography in 1964 when she adopted the camera used by the man she was later to marry, Daryl Tucker. During the early years of their marriage, her interest in photography grew as they spent some years living and travelling in the UK. Joan's love of inland Australia, particularly the red sand dunes, started in 1977 when she and her husband camped and toured in the Broken Hill area. Over the years that passion continued with many trips into remote areas of Australia and trips to the Republic of South Africa and Namibia. Her photographic talents blossomed further when she joined the Geelong Camera Club and then in 1999 the Australian Photographic Society. She was encouraged to enter National and International Exhibitions, which she started doing in 2001, and in the space of 6 years had achieved both her Fellow of the Australian Photographic Society (FAPS) and her AFIAP. She amassed hundreds of acceptances in International Salons around the world gaining over 40 International awards, and many more National awards, during this time. Broad in her talents she entered with success across many photographic subjects but she particularly shone in her talent with Creative Images and Nature Images. Her love of the Australian Outback, spending much time with her family and friends camping and driving off road into many untouched areas of this country, inspired much of her photography and saw her living life to the full with her husband, family and friends and a camera in hand to her final weeks,

A dedicated, reliable and tireless worker, Joan's commitment to the VIGEX salon exceeded that normally undertaken by the busy job of secretary. She thought outside the square, always innovative and progressive in her ideas, talents she applied to every aspect of her life. Despite her outstanding achievements in photography and the salon workload she took on, Joan was a modest person. She diligently and meticulously worked many long hours behind the scenes to ensure the smooth running of the salon securing strong foundations for the salon's future. She attacked everything that she did with great vigour and humility. Even when serious illness forced her resignation in the final month's lead up to the 2008 salon, she still found time and strength to diligently finalise VIGEX matters and hand them over in a highly organised fashion.

The loss of Joan so early was a loss to the world's photographic community. Not only was she an internationally successful photographer and respected photographic judge, she gave back to the world's photographic community in her years of service to the VIGEX Salon. From a personal perspective this salon not only lost a highly dedicated and hard working committee member but a special friend. We commend our Joan to the world's photographers and give tribute to her here, a role model to us all.

Despite the world economic downturn, the number of prints submitted was only 12% down on our 2008 record salon with 3490 entries from 44 countries, a most heartening result. For the first time online entry registration was made available with 43% of entrants taking up this opportunity, thus not only streamlining processing but ensuring greater accuracy of recording details.

As with previous salons, 2010 saw a great variety of images in all sections providing a most inspiring window on the world. Photography surely is an activity that both unites people around the world and encourages them to share their individual and unique views of this world.

The VIGEX Committee of Management takes pride in facilitating this sharing through promotion of quality photography. This would be impossible without the help and cooperative effort of many volunteers: the individual members of the organising committee, club members and friends and judges who gave many hours to preparation and judging of prints and organization of results for both the digital media and the printed catalogue. Thanks also must go to our wonderful sponsors and Friends of VIGEX, without whose support we could not exist.

We hope you enjoy this catalogue and will continue to support us by participating in future VIGEX Salons.

Salon Jury's Words

Kath Gillies - What a pleasure it was to Judge the creative section this year. There were some outstanding images with a very big variety of styles. Some stunning images from very creative photographers with a lot of thought put into the end result.

Denis Crawford - The judging of the nature section was as equally challenging as the Colour section (which I also judged) because of the great variety of subject matter and the number of entries. There were many excellent prints and each judge had their favourites. Fortunately the winning nature print was of such outstanding quality the judges were unanimous in selecting it for the award. It was with some despair though that I noticed a number of great images ruined by over sharpening. The management of the salon was outstanding. The sheer number of entries was mind boggling. The only suggestion on improvement is perhaps the organising committee could hold aside any prints which do not fit the stated criteria to reduce the number of prints for judging. The definition of 'nature' should also be made clearer – quite a number of prints had roads, buildings etc in the image. Perhaps a list of what domestic animals are (sheep, cattle, horses, honey bees etc). The Committee of Management should supply thermal underwear and polar jackets to all judges!

John Chapman - In Nature, was pleasing to see the diverse range of subject matter that was entered. While insects, animals, birds and flowers dominated the entries, a significant number illustrated other areas of natural history such as fungi, ice, snow, waterfalls, mountains, sand dunes, clouds and the sea. This wide range of subject matter was also reflected in the award winners. Unfortunately, a significant number of entries received low scores as they did not qualify as Nature Prints under FIAP and PSA rules. Reasons for low scores included the hand of man being present such as in buildings and roads, montages, cloning and digital treatments that were visible such as colour enhancement or excessive sharpening (very common). Entrants are advised to follow the rules as such prints would have been more appropriately entered in colour prints.

Mark Galer - Creative: This section attracts images from around the globe and allows contributors the freedom to express their creativity using a diverse range of conceptual ideas, camera craft and post-production skills. The photographers used artistic, graphic, fantastic, realistic and surrealist means of expressing their ideas. The outcomes were subtle or dramatic, dark or light and humorous. Sometimes the communication was clear, sometimes ambiguous but they all expressed their creators love to explore both concept and technique. Colour: This category is extremely popular with photographers who seek to explore a diverse range of subject matter in a variety of ways. Sometimes the colour palette used a broad range of colours to sweeten the viewers experience while other photographers chose to carefully limit or restrict the colour palette and modify or desaturate colors to invoke a specific mood. Some of the images were busy and vibrant while others took a minimalist approach to their design and use of colour. All photographers were to be congratulated on their creativity and need to communicate their vision of the world around them using photographic techniques.

James Cowie - Monochrome: The large number of prints in this section is testament to the continued interest in monochrome images in this digital era and it was with great pleasure that I judged this section. As expected, there was a huge range of subject matter from every corner of the globe. There were many inspiring works and the award winners were well deserving of their achievements. However, some prints were let down by over-sharpening, poor print quality or toning in an inappropriate colour. Photojournalism: It was good to see that there were many entrants who were prepared to put in the effort and submit entries in this difficult section. Subject matter was varied but was very much dominated by sports. Unfortunately, many good images were compromised by over-sharpening and poor print quality. Congratulations to all those who were accepted and those who won awards. Creative: This section certainly lived up to its name and I was amazed by the thought processes that must have gone through the entrants' minds. There were many stunning images and several images which showed a lively sense of humour, which is often difficult to achieve. Images which demonstrated solid pre-conception, careful execution and high print quality fared the best and these qualities were all clearly demonstrated in the award-winning prints. It was a real pleasure to judge this section. As far as the organisation of the judging goes, I would like to say that I was very impressed by the speed and efficiency with which everything ran, from the work by the print stewards, to those doing the computer work, the great work done by the caterers and everybody else who was there to lend a hand. Judges always receive the thanks but we have the easy part; those behind the scenes do most of the work and I would like to pass on my personal thanks to everyone who made the judging such a pleasurable occasion.

Geoffrey Edwards - The Portraits and People section is, I imagine, a mainstay of most photographic prizes and surveys and as such attracted, as most of us fully expected it to do, no shortage of grizzled and exotic faces shown full-frame, some even with eyes averted in the manner of an early Renaissance saint, in addition to assorted 'characters' both rude, rough and romantic seen mostly in their natural habitats. We found, likewise, a complement of coy and not-so-coy nudes and more than a few variations on the classic theme of the objectively observed individual, head or figure or both.

George Thomas - Being invited to judge the Monochrome Section of this world recognized International Exhibition of Photography was a privilege. Entries came from many countries with a large proportion from Asia and also the US. The quality of the prints was generally good to very high with a great variety of subject matter, but deciding the top print of the section, a stunning landscape, was a unanimous decision from all three judges. Very little discussion was needed as it stood out so prominently from the rest. The weekend of the judging was particularly cold and the building not heated but the camaraderie, together with tea breaks and excellent lunches, made up for physical discomforts.
