2022 has been another interesting year for the Vigex Salon.

Once again we were delighted with the high standard of the entries we received. We congratulate all those whose work has been accepted into the exhibition, particularly the makers of the awarded images which you can enjoy at our exhibition or in this catalogue.

The total number of entries this year is only 1005, well under half the number we had for our last print salon. Interestingly the number of Australian entries is almost unchanged, but the international entries have dropped by 82%. After seeing a gradual rise in international support for our print salons since 2015 we can only hope this drop has been a reflection of short-term influences like lockdowns, travel restrictions and the uncertainty of postal delivery times.

We thank the Geelong Library and Heritage Centre for providing the exhibition space, and our judges, helpers, sponsors and Friends of Vigex who all do so much to make our salon possible.

We also thank all our entrants and look forward to seeing much more of their work in our upcoming salons. In 2023 we will conduct a digital image salon, then a print salon in 2024.

I sincerely thank the Vigex management and committee for giving me the opportunity to judge this premier international print competition. The whole judging weekend went smoothly and professionally. Special thanks to the tireless volunteers who assisted the judges.

Printing is my photographic passion from the days in the darkroom to nowadays with digital editing. Seeing prints from photo artists from all over the world was a special treat. The diversity of subjects and how those subjects were handled and portrayed, gave me great pleasure and motivation in my own photographic journey.

<u>Monochrome</u>: There were many interesting styles and subject treatments with a general high standard of work presented. A few prints had technical issues like poor resolution or over sharpening. However the standard was generally high with prints displaying good tonal range, clarity and craftsmanship. Obviously the top entries strongly displayed what I call the wow factor and caught the judge's attention by strongly demonstrating all the factors previously mentioned.

\*Entering an international print salon requires premium prints, produced on good quality papers with varying surfaces to best treat the subject. Ensuring the prints have strong subject, good technical detail and full range of mono tones with monochrome prints. Colour prints need good tonal range, colour balance and saturation suitable for the subject displayed.

<u>Creative</u>: This section included a wide range of subjects and treatments with varying skill levels and interpretations. Unfortunately, some entries did not meet the criteria or were technically poor. Some entries were very well composited and eye catching and were awarded. Some entries needed a little more attention to detail and finessing which would have elevated them higher. I found the overall standard of work to be good and well done to those who entered this section. The concepts and visualizations of the entrants was amazing. Please refer to \* above with regards to print making.

<u>Nature</u>: The overall standard was good however a few entries were eliminated due to vignettes or breaches of the rules. Entrants need to adhere to the salon rules. Many images were marked down or disqualified due to the presence of buildings, fences and overhead wires. I.e. The hand of man.

There were some excellent entries and the winning photographs satisfied excellent technical skills, strong subject and print quality. Unfortunately, a few entries scored poorly because of basic technical or skill problems such as out of focus or over sharpened or poor print making. (see \* above). Careful image editing and print making, (including appropriate paper choice), should be considered to elevate an entry above the other entries.



Heather Prince MAPS, EFIAP

I was honoured and very humbled to be asked to be part of the judging panel for the VIGEX Print Salon 2022. I am a passionate advocate for the printed photograph so I thoroughly enjoyed participating in this International showcase of prints. To me prints are the ultimate medium for your photographs. Prints indicate a photographer's pride in his/her images and respect for the photographic process. Prints are tangible. They are a physical celebration of a photographer's work.

The overall standard of prints in this salon was very good. However, I was disappointed with the number of average quality entries. I look for quality pre-processing as preparation for printing and suitable print paper. Quality print paper does make such a difference and it was sad to see good images downgraded because of the quality of paper used. But, accolades to those printers out there. Keep it up.

I judged the Monochrome, Travel and Creative sections.

#### Monochrome

Monochrome removes colour as a distraction allowing the viewer to concentrate on the elements of design in the image and the motif. The awarded images were printed on quality paper and had the full range of contrast, excellent lighting and an engaging motif. Subject matter included travel, architecture and portraits. Overall I could say that the monochrome section was well supported by accomplished photographers who submitted high quality work.

#### Creative

Successful Creative imaging relies on a very different set of skills to regular photographic imaging. The maker must have an innovative imagination, exceptional processing skills and the ability to present a challenging narrative. We enjoyed a vast range of subject matter and some intriguing stories in the prints submitted. The most successful images displayed a talent for flawless compositing and an intent to intrigue the viewer. There were also a number of very simple creative images that stood out because of their cleverness and the statement they made.

#### Travel

I was relieved to notice that the number of staged travel images was well down this year. Many of the images celebrated the diversity and uniqueness of different cultures and landscapes and the awarded images were not only exceptionally shot but they conveyed a strong statement about issues in society today. Often with Travel photography you only have one chance to capture what you see so minor technical issues can be overlooked if the image has a powerful statement to make. Considering that people have been unable to travel recently because of COVID constraints it was good to see a variety of excellent images.

Congratulations to all those who work so hard to make VIGEX happen! It was a pleasure and a privilege to be invited as part of the judging panel for the 2022 VIGEX Print Salon. The four sections I judged were Monochrome, Creative, Travel and 'Scapes, and there are some general observations I'd like to make that relate to all these sections.

Photography is an art form that is absolutely part of contemporary art practice, and as such needs to be seen in a wider context of the visual arts.

With some notable exceptions, I felt there was a reluctance to take risks, to engage with contemporary photographic practice and move away from imagery that is almost becoming cliché in salons around the world. Technically, much of the work was of a high standard and there were some extraordinary images that showed a real sense of 21<sup>st</sup> century social awareness.

At this level of photographic competition, I would expect to see style and mastery of technique that allows the maker to explore new ideas, new perspectives and contemporary statements through the photographic process. Some photographers demonstrated this extremely well, through bold, challenging images as well as those who explored subtle and beautiful narratives.

**Monochrome:** The range of subject matter in this section was excellent and included some interesting images that also explored altered reality as the visual intent. A number of portraits, social documentary and landscape images demonstrated mastery of technique and the ability to capture mood, and I commend all entrants who have received awards.

**Creative** is an exciting section to judge because the image-maker is being invited to take more risks and challenge not only their own thinking but also that of the viewer. 'Creative' is not only about using digital techniques, but can be about the possibilities of changing the actual photographic surface. This is the only section in the salon where the perfection of surface can be challenged. Altering the reality of a traditional photographic image introduces an immediate visual response to the changed and unexpected texture. There were a few entrants who responded by exploring a sense of contradiction, asking the viewer to question and consider other possibilities. I congratulate and thank all the award winners who took risks and created imaginative thought-provoking imagery.

**Travel:** There was an interesting range of responses to the concept of travel, but it was apparent that too many entrants did not read the rules that were quite specific. Congratulations to the entrants who have received awards.

**'Scapes:** A challenging, section, there was a reluctance to find new perspectives for the concept of a 'vista'. Arguably, horizons are not compulsory, and I commend those who explored visual elements such as repetition of forms, and underlying abstract qualities as important aspects of their images. Congratulations to all the award winners.

I was delighted to accept the invitation to judge the 21<sup>st</sup> Vigex International Print Salon, after being very disappointed in 2020 when it had to be cancelled due to the pandemic. My partner Matt and I run a photography gallery in beautiful Bright, so I am well aware of both the frustrations and the joys of printing, but viewing an excellent image that has been well-printed on a suitable paper type is a much more rewarding experience than viewing it on a digital device, so it was a pleasure and a privilege to view and judge the images submitted to the Open Colour, Scapes, and Travel sections of this year's Salon.

Overall, the quality of the work in the **Open Colour** and **Scapes** sections was excellent. Unfortunately, in the **Travel** section, many of the best images didn't comply with the strict definition of Travel as outlined by FIAP and PSA and were scored accordingly. There were also quite a few undersized prints submitted in all three categories, so I strongly urge all entrants to carefully read all the Conditions of Entry prior to selecting and printing their submissions.

The **Open Colour** section was a joy to judge. There were many outstanding entries, but the prints that stood out were those that were not only fantastic images, but were also superbly printed on a paper type that was clearly selected to enhance the photograph. Printing can be an expensive process, but it is worthwhile experimenting with different paper types, as a glossy finish isn't always the best choice!

As a landscape photographer, I was really looking forward to judging the **Scapes** section, and I wasn't disappointed. There were some stunning prints submitted, making the selection of the award-winning entries very challenging. The highest-scoring images exemplified the idea of a vista or broad view of a scene rather than a more intimate view, and again, entrants who took care to select paper types that enhanced their prints were rewarded in this section.

It was genuinely disappointing that many high-impact prints that were submitted to the **Travel** category didn't comply with the strict PSA Photo Travel definition. The photographs that stood out were those that were authentic "in-the-moment" captures rather than contrived set-ups, and it was wonderful to view each photograph up close and be transported visually to so many intriguing places and cultures all across our fascinating world.

In all categories, a lively discussion took place between the judges when making the final assessments of the award-winning prints, taking into account the subject matter, the technique and the print quality of the highest-scoring photographs. I'd like to extend a heart-felt congratulations to all award-winning entrants – it was a pleasure to judge your work!

Finally, I'd like to express my gratitude to the VIGEX Committee, to all the volunteers, and to the wonderful judges who made the weekend so enjoyable. Many people gave up their time and talent – before, during and after the judging – and we are fortunate indeed to have been involved in such a well-run and successful print Salon.

As an emergency judge, I was called upon to judge the "Colour" section.

Entries were less than last time, when I judged, but the quality was high, despite the quantity being low. There were also many exceptional images in the salon and this made the judging process difficult in selection, which is a good thing.

It was also good to see that print makers were selecting paper to suitably enhance the finished product, one more step to consider when it comes to print over digital projection.

Post processing, I feel is where some makers let themselves down, with overworking. Fortunately there wasn't too many like that and I do think that people are starting to take that into consideration, which I believe is important.

Congratulations to all entrants, but especially to those who received an award.

Thanks also to the VIGEX committee and their army of volunteers, a very smooth running of the judging weekend.

As a general comment I would like to thank the Vigex team for the opportunity to judge a lovely selection of prints after COVID stopped many of the print competitions. It's good to be back!

#### Colour

As you can see from the awarded images the selection received was diverse. The quality of printing was generally very good- it is always a bit shattering to see a good image lose points due to the quality of the print. This year the portraits were particularly strong but it was also good to see some different subject matter including a very well rendered oil and water image, some strong landscapes and some still life work. Well done to those who managed to get their images onto paper- please keep it up!

#### Nature

This is one of the sections that is always hard to judge as we must try to image the reality of the situation as it took place- the rules limit the changes that can be made to the images and unfortunately some photographers persist in over processing the reality divisions. In addition to some well captured bird photos there were a number of different subjects that took awards. We had bears, cuttlefish and mating tortoises amongst the top images. Congratulations to those who received awards and acceptances.

It was an honour and a privilege to be asked to be a member of the panel to judge the Nature Section of the Vigex 21st International Photographic Print Salon 2022. I commend the Vigex Committee for their exemplary organisation of the Salon. Recognition must also be given to the many volunteers who assisted in the conduct of the Salon.

All entrants are to be congratulated for entering their prints for consideration by the judges, particularly given the logistical difficulties associated with delivery of prints in uncertain times.

There were some excellent Nature prints entered in the Salon across a wide range of nature subjects. My primary criterion for judging was the story telling value of the print. Of importance also was a high technical standard and overall pictorial quality. I believe these qualities are well represented in the awarded prints.

Some prints narrowly missed receiving an award on the basis of technical issues, such as oversharpening resulting in halos being visible around the subject or in the sense of an overall unnatural looking print. In others, the subject's eyes were slightly out of focus.

In some instances, the prints did not meet the Nature rules applicable to the Salon and these prints were necessarily awarded a mark of "1", notwithstanding that the prints may have received a higher score had they been entered in an Open section. In particular, prints which included people or human elements such as fences or cultivated plants did not comply with the Nature rules.

There was a large variation in the style of papers used for the prints which is an important aspect of a print salon. Some of the fine art papers enhanced the entry whilst other very glossy papers slightly detracted.

I hope you enjoy the Vigex 2022 Catalogue and I wish you every success in your future photography endeavours.
